A penalty notice is a type of financial penalty you must pay!

From 19th August 2024 you will be issued a Penalty Notice if your child has a total of 10 sessions of unauhorised absence which equates to 5 school days.

Penalty Notices are issued to each parent, per child.

Legal proceeding may be taken against parent/carer if payment of the

Penalty Notice is not made within 28 days.



First Offence

When a Penalty Notice is issued per parent, per child, you must pay:

- £80 if paid by parent/carer within 21 days
- £160 if paid by parent/carer after 21 days but within 28 days.



Second Offence within 3 years

Second penalty notice within 3 years will result in £160 per parent per child which will need to be paid within 28 days.



Any other offence within 3 years

Legal proceedings may be taken against you if:
Your child has any further unauthorised absences within 3 years, which may
also result in you being referred to the LA Attendance Officer to monitor your
child's attendance.
