RECEPTION VISIT TO BARKING PARK

This term in Reception, the children will be learning about 'Moving on and Journeys', and as part of this learning, we will be taking a bus to Barking Park on Friday 14th June 2024.

On the day of the visit, children should arrive at the school at the normal time of 8:40am and in school uniform. It is advisable that parents check the weather forecast that day and ensure that pupils are appropriately dressed; weather dependent please make sure that you provide your child with a coat, or if it is a hot day, please ensure you apply sun cream to your child before school and provide them with a sun hat (sun glasses are not required as they may get lost).

We will be taking the bus to and from Barking Park and will be leaving school at 9:30am returning to school for 3:00pm. Children should be collected at normal home time of 3:20pm.

We will be having a picnic at the park so children should bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag (no glass bottles / plastic containers) and a water bottle. A packed lunch can be provided by the school if you tick the box below.
