Year3 Trip to The Tower of London

As part of our History learning in Year 3, we are exploring the topic, Crime and Punishment and as part of this we will be visiting The Tower of London, on **Wednesday 15th May**.

Whilst at the Tower we will be taking part and engaging in a crime and punishment workshop.

A costumed presenter from the Tower will help pupils to connect and contrast different stories from the Tower's past, whilst exploring some of the historic spaces used to hold prisoners. In the afternoon we will be taking a look around the Tower before coming back to school.

On the day of this school visit, children should arrive at school at the usual time of 08:40am in school uniform. It is advisable that parents check the weather forecast that day and ensure that pupils are appropriately dressed.

We will be taking the train to Tower Hill station and then walking to the Tower, which will be during normal school hours. We will be leaving promptly after registration at 09:00am and returning for the end of the normal school day.

We will be eating at the venue so children should bring a healthy packed lunch in a disposable bag (no glass bottles / plastic containers) and a water bottle. A packed lunch can be provided by the school if you tick the box below.

We are asking for a payment of £6.00 to go towards the cost of the workshop. Please pay this via ParentPay.
